Other of her patterns or the student's own design may also be used. Day one will progress with design transfer, fusing and some sewing. On day two, Lenore will demonstrate how to add fabric painting to the design to add detail and depth—students will be encouraged to paint on their own designs. Students have the option of taking the Impressionistic Fabric Art workshop for one or two days
