Artist Victoria Kelly has been working with fibers for over 40 years. She has exhibited her work widely and has won numerous awards in her career. In 1990, she and her husband moved to a lake in the Manistee National Forest. The change in atmosphere caused her to emphasize the natural world in her work, and she has been exploring that world ever since.

Victoria will be presenting a lecture describing the process she goes through in creating her wall hangings, including layering fabrics, appliqué, painting and adding three dimensional forms. Several unfinished pieces will demonstrate progression of the work. Students will then participate in a hands-on lesson on fabric printing.
